Pernilla Edlund's Ginger Snaps recipe

Ingredients

- 250g (2 cups) of pastry flour
- 45g (1 ½ teaspoons) of baking soda
- 15g (½ teaspoon) of salt
- 15g (½ teaspoon) of ground ginger
- 15g (½ teaspoon) of ground cloves
- 15g (½ teaspoon) of cinnamon
- 90g (3/4 cup) of butter
- 90g (3/4 cup) of white sugar
- 15g (1/4 cup) of molasses
- 1 egg

Instructions

- Mix pastry flour, baking soda, salt, ginger, cinnamon, and cloves and then set aside
- Add the flour mixture to the butter and mix at a slow speed until combined
- Wrap the combined mixture in plastic wrap, seal tightly, and then store in the freezer for 20-30 minutes
- Preheat oven to 175C (350F)
- Line a baking sheet with parchment paper
- Place 75g (½ cup) of white sugar in a small bowl
- Find a drinking glass with a flat bottom
- Remove one portion of the dough from the freezer
- Roll dough into balls of 2cm (3/4 inch)
- Place the dough ball into the cup of water with sugar, then place the ball on the baking sheet
- Allow for 2.5cm (1 inch) space between dough balls on the baking sheet
- Use the flat-bottom cup to press and flatten each dough ball
- Place the baking sheet in the oven for 8-10 minutes or until cookies are set
- Ensure that the centre of the cookie remains chewy
- Repeat with the remaining dough
